The Power I Program at CASC is a welfare-to-work initiative in Oklahoma in conjunction with the Department of Human Services and OSRHE. Power I was created to enhance, to prepare, and to create a competitive workforce. Clients are recipients of the Temporary Aid for Needy Families (TANF) Program and are able to receive specialized training in areas such as social awareness, resume preparation, job interviewing, workforce skills, personal growth, and hygiene. On-the-job training, job shadowing, and specialized workshops are available, and participants also are encouraged to take college classes and to complete an associate degree.
