Ref: Cross Deputation Agreement

On January 23, 2006 the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) and the State of Oklahoma has updated a new Cross Deputation Agreement. In this new agreement the important change was the Tort Claim. Officers that is providing services in Indian Country would be deemed employees of the Department of the Interior for purpose of the Federal Tort Claims Act while enforcing or carrying out the Laws of the United States covered by this deputation agreement.

The purpose of this Agreement is to provide for efficient, effective, and cooperative law enforcement efforts in and around Indian Country in the State of Oklahoma. Accordingly, all parties to this Agreement shall cooperate with each other to provide comprehensive and thorough law enforcement protection, including but not limited to effecting arrests, responding to calls for assistance from all citizens and also from other law enforcement officers.

Mass Immunization/Prophylaxis Site Agreement

The Carl Albert State College, 1507 S. McKenna, Moteau OK, hereby acknowledges its intent to allow the use of its facilities in the event of a biological terrorist emergency or large natural disaster. In making this acknowledgment, we agree to do the following:


1. Provide facilities that can be used for feeding and rest areas for volunteer workers in the event of an emergency.
2. Provide space for a warehouse, clinic site, command site, staging area and/or credentialing area as needed in the event of an emergency.
3. Designate three points of contact in case of emergency:
 - a. An Administrator, who will serve as the primary point of contact. This person should have authority to open up the building.
 - b. A facilities management point of contact, who will work with health department personnel to move tables, chairs, etc.
 - c. A security point of contact, who will interact with the local law enforcement in making security plans.
4. Allow our facility to be visited by members of the Oklahoma State Department of Health, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and all other county/city officials working in conjunction with the dispensing plan for the development and maintenance of a site-dispensing plan.
5. Allow our facility to be listed in a confidential appendix to the Oklahoma State Strategic National Stockpile Plan.

As part of this agreement, we expect the county health department to:

1. Provide a point of contact to answer questions that our institution might have about these arrangements.
2. In the event of an emergency, provide health and/or security professionals who would meet people at the entrance of our facility and, to the best of their ability, prevent contagious people from entering the building.
3. Coordinate the provision of extra security personnel, provide any post-event cleanup that is needed and do all that it can to reimburse the facility for expenses incurred as a result of using our facility.

In making this agreement, we will maintain, and do not relinquish, our flexibility to make arrangement that will minimize the disruption that serving as an SNS dispensing site would entail.
